CHAIRMAN's REPORT

At our last meeting we farewelled the 2017-18 District Governors from our Board of Directors and thank them for their time, input and service.

Our next meeting has been brought forward to August 5th after which our AGM will be held, ALL "N" District Clubs are the owners and members of the Foundations and earnestly invited to attend. The Save Sight Community Challenge Presentation Dinner will be on Saturday evening the 4th, Again you are encouraged to attend. Saturday afternoon will be Committee meetings and training for 1st VDG's, new Directors and incoming Community Challenge District Chairs.

On the 9th May I did an interview with "Talking with Toby" for Townsville Community Radio T.V. Although our Foundations are "N" districts, it went over well and is generating interest in what we do. Our Directors will be pleased that I have now bought 32 USB "sticks" and when I work out what has happened to "my computer" on the computer I will be sending several "Power Point" presentations to them and our Regional Chairs to better inform Clubs etc.

I have been appointed again as your representative on the Investment Committee of the Sydney Eye Hospital Trust which means at least six additional trips to Sydney annually as usual plus two extra to meet with our investment brokers.

The Lions NSW Eye Bank with the NSW Bone and Tissue Bank is making mind boggling advances. The "Bio pen" is now to human trials, most people have "holes" in their corneas, this "pen" using "ink" from debris in corneal transplants is wiped over the affected cornea and fills in the holes often alleviating the need for a transplant. Also great strides are being made using amnions from caesarean section births, (natural birth places great stress upon the amnion). These amnions are collected from the Mater birthing unit and used in eye surgery as well as for grafts in burns cases.

Watch this Space.

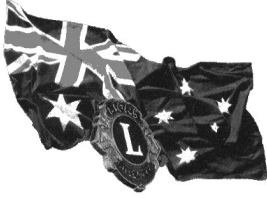
